What is it?

- Is this licensure?
- What is required to be registered?
 - Can you provide a chart detailing the registrations, requirements for each, and length of validity?
- What documentation do I get that verifies I am on the LCD Registry? (verification card)
- What happens to the current/old registry(ies)?
 - If I am on the current LCD Registry – what do I need to do?

Who has to do it?

- Who is required to register?
- Can I still work as an interpreter in LA, if I'm not registered?
- Will remote (VRS/VRI) interpreters (non-Louisiana residents) be required to register?
- What will the sanctions be against those who are working but not registered?

How do I do it?

- What is the process for registering with LCD?
- If I am certified (RID or BEI), what do I need to do, and by when?
- If I am not yet certified what do I need to do, and by when?
- How will I renew my registration?

General questions

- Where can we find the **entire** proposed Administrative Code for sign language interpreters?
- What are the timelines for the process now that LCD has approved the content? (NOI, public hearings, final approval, etc.)
- What is LCD doing to help us get ready?
- Will LCD help with test costs before July 1, 2026?
